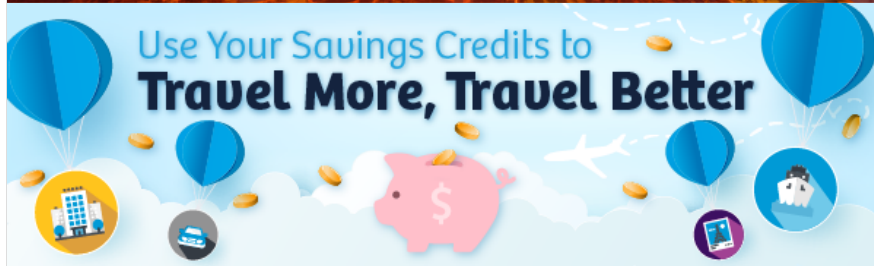
**Other News**
